

The National Institute for Health Research (NIHR) not only expects but requires NIHR Newcastle Biomedical Research Centre (BRC) support or funding to be acknowledged in all research output.

WHAT is funded by the BRC?

NIHR Newcastle BRC funding and support comes in many forms.

DIRECT PROJECT FUNDING

CO-FUNDING

If your research has been co-funded or received support from multiple organisations, including if it was other NIHR infrastructure, please include them all.

FUNDING OF SALARIES

If a researcher's salary is paid by the BRC in full or in part (e.g. contributions to clinical academic salaries), ALL of their publications should acknowledge BRC support.

INFRASTRUCTURE & INDIRECT SUPPORT

We also support essential clinical research infrastructure, including (but not limited to):

- technology platforms
- training schemes
- tissue banking
- informatics support
- information governance
- clinical trials expertise
- key NHS support services
- research nurses and trial coordinators
- project support

WHEN do I need to acknowledge?

In any communication arising from BRC-funded research that enters the public domain.

WHERE do I put my acknowledgement?

In the acknowledgement or funding section of a publication.

OR

In the supporting information IF there is a linking statement in the main body of the article.

In the main body of the press release or news article

(optional) Also in the notes to editors along with additional information about the NIHR.

The acknowledgement of NIHR Newcastle BRC funding or support needs to be somewhere prominent in other published materials.

You must also use the NIHR visual identity appropriately. Templates are available for posters and presentations along with a range of logos (NIHR, NIHR Newcastle BRC, Supported by NIHR and Funded by NIHR)

Please give the BRC core team as much advance notice as possible that you intend to publish research, so that the team have time to prepare and liaise with the NIHR, University and Hospitals Trust to maximise coverage. Remember that you also need to send a copy of the paper/article/output to BRC.Publications@newcastle.ac.uk, preferably at least 14 days before it is due to be published so it can be sent to NIHR for review.
